The Colton and Loma Linda Fire Departments are holding Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) training for new members.

The CERT team, comprised of community members, is trained to provide assistance to their families, neighbors, and the community during a disastrous event.

CERT members receive a minimum of **20 hours** of training on disaster preparedness, light fire suppression, basic medical aid, light search and rescue, and team operations.

All residents and businesses are welcome! Those who complete the training receive a backpack, helmet, vest, safety glasses, and gloves.
